From the Pastor...

It has been a blessed year for me to be of service to Pastor John and the congregation here at Peace. It is wonderful to see Pastor John getting stronger and being able to look forward to his return to fully serving as your pastor.

A highlight of this past year for me has been teaching Sunday Morning Bible Class. Preparing by going to the biblical text in service to the congregation and our need for a word from the Lord, listening to scripture, asking the Holy Spirit to enliven the word and speak to us so that we might hear God talk to us— his people.

Reading through the Old Testament, hearing and discussing—submitting ourselves to these ancient texts, expecting a word to come to our contemporary context—is exciting, yet a strange, atypical move for us modern people. We like to think of ourselves as people who are making progress, overcoming the old way with better ways—something better because it is new. Not the same old, same old.

But in the church, we submit to the saints. We ponder the words, lives, and examples of those who have walked the path of Christ before us and ask them to show us the way. We submit ourselves to the testimony of dead people—Abraham, Issac, Jacob— Moses—Joshua, Ruth, Esther, Job, the prophets, and see them set the context for Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Mary and Joseph and Mary and Martha and St. Paul. No one who has been living for at least 2000 years speaks to us in scripture. By word and example, they show us the way; all scripture, in one way or another, is testimony from the saints, those who have walked the path of faith in the Messiah, the Christ, before us.

I want to express to the congregation the joy I have experienced as we have recalled their stories anew— listening to their lives. And miraculously, wonder of wonders, by the action of the Holy Spirit, through the inspiration of Jesus, these long dead figures walk among us, speak to us, make us laugh, make us cry, pierce us through the heart—point us to the way, connecting our souls— our very being.

I've spent the last 52 weeks listening to your stories. Not counting the seven months I was filling in at Trinity—Paso, I was the pastor for only one other congregation. So it has been an exciting new challenge to get to understand a new congregation. To get to know you—ask, in effect, "Tell me your story. How did you get here? What's the best thing ever happening to you in this congregation? When has this church had to struggle to survive? Tell me about

that. What makes You, that is, *all You all* as a congregation. Tell me your adventures with God in Christ."

That's sort of the same thing I've attempted to do every Sunday. To go to the ancient biblical texts and say to saints long dead, "Tell me your story. What's the most interesting adventure you have had with God? What do you have to share with us?"

Lots of congregations and many individual Christians, myself included, need just that encouragement these days. A year ago the congregation faced a huge challenge with the announcement of Pastor John's diagnosis, and sometimes, we feel overwhelmed by the tasks that confront us. I know at times I have been. But what better time, therefore, to spend time listening to the scriptures and the stories about God and his dealings with those who have gone before us?

Thank you for this opportunity to get to know you and serve you.




