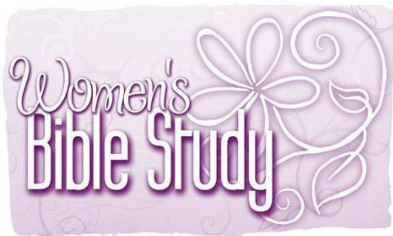


# BIBLE STUDY OPPORTUNITIES AT PEACE

All ladies are welcome.

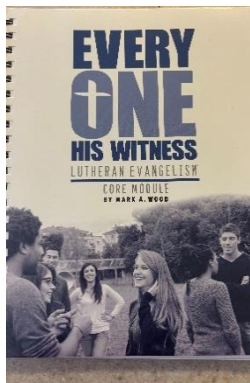
## Community Bible Study

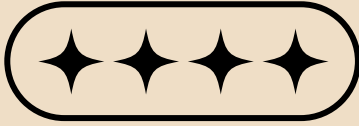

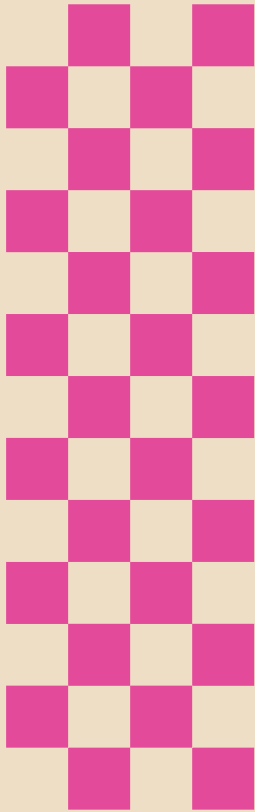

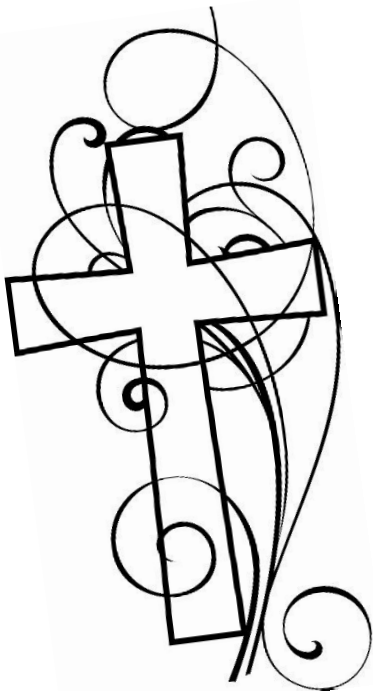
